RULES & REGULATIONS

TYPES OF MEMBERSHIPS

1. RIDING MEMBERS:

(Elementary Riding Activities only)

- Entrance fee - Rs.50,000/- (Non-refundable)
- Riding fee - Rs.6,100/- per month, to be paid in advance. (3 days a week)
- Riding fee - Rs. 12,100/- per month, to be paid in advance. (6 days a week)

2. NRI/EXPAT MEMBERS:

(Elementary Riding Activities only)

- Entrance fee -Rs.60,000/- (Non-refundable)
- Riding fee -Rs. 9,400/- per month, to be paid in advance. (3 days a week)
- Rs. 18,800/- per month, to be paid in advance. (6 days a week)

3. STUDENT MEMBERS (15 Years and Below: (EVENING CLASSES)

(Elementary Riding Activities only)

- Entrance Fee- Rs.50,000/- (Non - refundable)
- Riding Fee - Rs. 3,900/- per month, to be paid in advance. (2 days a week)

Students who wish to ride in the morning or wish to learn/take part in Jumping / Dressage can opt for 6 rides per week in the mornings or evenings. The revised fee will be applicable in such cases.

During summer, there will be no evening riding classes for students. There will be only theory sessions twice a week on the weekends for all students

4. NRI/EXPAT STUDENT MEMBERS (15 Years and Below): (EVENING CLASSES)

(Elementary Riding Activities only)

- Entrance fee- Rs.60,000/- (Non-refundable)
- Riding fee- Rs. 6,250/- per month, to be paid in advance. (2 days a week)
- Riding fee- Rs.12,500/- per month, to be paid in advance. (6 days a week)

5. YOUNG RIDER (PONIES ONLY): Age 3 to 6 years

Entrance fee:	Rs. 25,000/-	Rs. 30,000/-
Riding fee per month:(2 rides per week)	Rs. 3,900/-	Rs. 6,200/-

Please note: Young Rider membership will be commuted to Student Member once they reach the age of 7 years, and are required to pay the difference in the Entrance Fee (Indian members Rs. 25,000; NRI/Expat members Rs. 30,000)



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6. SHORT COURSE

An Introduction to Horses:

- 6 sessions, each of 30 minutes duration
- Timings: mornings – 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 a.m./ evenings – 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- Classes options:
- Tuesday to Sunday
- Certificate will be given after completion of course
- Course Fee: Rs. 9,500/- to be paid in advance

7. PLEASURE RIDES

EVENING/MORNING

Rs. 1,500/- per ride of 30 minutes with/without syce/groom

Advance booking required. Rides will be allotted subject to availability of horses and the level of the rider.

8. GUEST RIDE

Members are permitted up to two guest rides per month, with the following charges:
Guest ride fee for member's guest - Rs. 1,000/- per ride of 30 minutes. Members to inform in advance. Ride will be given subject to availability of horses.

GENERAL:

a) Usage Fee:

Riding Members will pay a minimum Usage fee of Rs. 250 per month, payable in advance, along with the monthly subscription. This amount of Rs. 250/- will be adjusted on the basis of attendance, @ Rs. 30/- per session.

b) Club House Maintenance Fee:

Minimum of Rs. 100 per month (adjustable) is to be paid by all categories of members.

c) Membership fee to be **paid before the 10th of every month** irrespective of whether the member rides that particular month. No provision for absentee membership. If a member defaults for more than a month, his/her membership will be terminated.

d) Payment may be by Cash or by Cheque(to be issued in favour of Madras Riding School). No credit cards. Online transfer also available, please contact us for details.



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RIDING TIMINGS:

1. RIDING MEMBERS(only in the Mornings):

5:30 a.m. to 7.30 a.m. on all days except on Monday. No riding on Monday (weekly Club holiday)

Members to be present at the stable 15 minutes before their class time.

Days & Timing will be confirmed on approval of membership and depending on the riding ability of the member.

2. STUDENT MEMBERS (only in the Evenings):

• 2 nd Batch	5:00 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.	4:45 p.m. to 5:15 p.m.
• 3 rd Batch	5:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.	5:15 p.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Members to be present at the stable 15 minutes before their class time.

No riding on Mondays.

Days & Timing will be confirmed later on approval of membership.

*** PLEASE NOTE: TIMINGS MUST BE STRICTLY ADHERED TO.**

- If more than 10 minutes late, the horse will not be available for the ride.
- All rides are 30 minutes, except if given specific programme to work on by the instructor.
- If a member is unable to attend a riding class, the same must be informed the previous day.



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DRESS CODE:

Members and Guests will be required to ride in proper outfit consisting of a pair of

- Breeches (members) or Jeans (guests),
- Boots or closed leather shoes with leather soles and heels (no Canvas / Sneakers allowed);
- Riding Helmet is compulsory.
- Club T-Shirts to be well tucked in.
- If dressed otherwise, Club's horses will not be made available.

Club T-shirts, Breeches and Riding Helmet are available at the Club Stores.

GENERAL RULES:

- i. All Members / Students should be subject to the discipline of the Institute and maintain cordial relationship with other riders and staff.
- ii. The Members / Students / Guests are themselves entirely responsible for any injury or accident that may occur to them while riding or in the stable area or while participating in other activities connected with horses and will not claim from Madras Riding School or its officials and staff any compensation whatsoever.
- iii. All members must read and sign the Indemnity Form and understand that equestrian sport and horsemanship is a high-risk activity.
- iv. All members are advised to take adequate insurance at their own cost, as this is a high-risk sport. The Club will not be responsible for any injury.
- v. Members / Students shall abide by the instructions given by the Riding Instructor or the President of the Madras Riding School regarding the horse / pony that is allocated for their ride.
- vi. No member is to ride alone, except as per the instructions of the instructor.
- vii. Individual Schooling programmes given to members to follow must be adhered to and should not be deviated from by any other activity, riding or otherwise. Individual feedback to be reported to the instructor after each such ride.
- viii. Members wishing to switch their riding days from 3 days to 6 days per week or vice versa, cannot switch back for a period of at least 3 months.
- ix. A Guest may be introduced for riding not more than two times in one calendar month by any members.
- x. Members introducing Guests will be held responsible in the event of the Guest violating any of the above rules. It will be the sole responsibility of the Member to acquaint his / her Guest of the above rules of riding. All fees of Members' Guests will be recoverable from the members only.
- xi. Names of Members / Students who have not paid their bills for the period exceeding two calendar months would be put on notice board and they will not be permitted to ride.



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- xii. Members defaulting in payment for more than 2 months would be removed from the Membership and they would have to re-apply as a new Member after settling their previous arrears.
- xiii. Light snacks/breakfast/coffee/tea are available at the Club Pantry.
- xiv. The objective of Madras Riding School is to impart to it's members a good foundation in equestrian & horsemanship skills through proper instruction, coaching and training. Members are expected to participate in in-house equestrian sport shows, which will serve as an assessment of their skill and progress, as well as in all of the planned activities that serve to build up positive team spirit.
- xv. Theory sessions, workshops, clinics are planned to further the education of the member. Members are expected to take part in these.
- xvi. All members are required to participate in In-House Shows and Programmes, which will serve as an assessment of their riding skills.
- xvii. A vital part of the learning of this sport is an understanding and sensitization towards horses. Members are encouraged to further their education through practical, hands-on interaction, communication and bonding with horses through stable chores.
- xviii. In-house activities like games, movie shows, quiz contests etc. are activities that bring members together in a social atmosphere. Members are expected to be present and actively participate in these and to volunteer assistance in areas that they are able to help out in.
